ABOUT THE CHHAYGAON COLLEGE

Founded on a vision to strive for higher level of achievement by providing quality education, Chhaygaon College has been pursuing its goal as pioneer of higher education for about five decades in the greater Chhaygaon area homeland of heterogeneous racial elements. The inception of the College on the 6th September, 1974 at Chhaygaon in the district of Kamrup was the inevitable culmination of an avowed mission and a prolonged involvement, with an unceasing effort, of a band of dedicated and distinguished patrons of learning of the area. Despite numerous setbacks, the College grew healthy with the passage of time and developed into a full-fledged coeducational institution making provision for instruction to Post Graduate to Degree level of Major and General courses in Arts and Commerce streams under Gauhati University and registered under U.G.C.2(f)/12(B). The college also runs the Higher Secondary section in Arts and Commerce with permanent registration of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. In response to the changing perceptions in needs and expectations in the fast paced developing environment, the College is making every endeavour to open a number of Diploma and Undergraduate courses along with the traditional Science stream from H.S. level. The College volunteered to be assesses by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) which, after assessment, declared the College as accredited at the B level in 2015 (2nd cycle).

LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

The College is ideally situated at an easily accessible location at Chhaygaon - a place that can boast of its cultural diversities and rich heritage. It stands besides the National Highway No. 17 at a distance of about 40 Kilometers west of the Gauhati University and about 30 Kilometers from the Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi Airport. The Capital Complex at Dispur is about 50 Kilometers away from the College. The College campus, spread over an extensive area, is grand with luxuriant green field and shady trees free from the pollution crowded environment.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Optimal use of these ecological services can play a significant role in livelihood sustainability as well as further contribute to sustainable development. However a struggle for growth and excellence has created imbalance in economic development among the countries, depleted some of the natural resources and have does alter the ecological balance. Since these threaten the very existence of human life on earth, therefore course of action that would ensure safe environment for future generation has become the need of the hour. Keeping this in mind, the Department of Economics and Department Commerce of Chhaygaon College, Chhaygaon propose to hold a two days national seminar to address various livelihood strategies that can be useful in attaining sustainable development goals. Font size should be 14 point for title, 12 point for the rest of the text and line spacing 1.5. Please provide a margin of the One (1) inch on all sides and text should be justified
- Joint paper presenters have to register separately
- Selected papers will be published in Seminar Proceedings with ISBN.
